

The Shepherd's Way Search and Rescue Training

To better prepare members of the community to be able to further assist families in the future who may be faced with the unfortunate situation in which their child goes missing, the family of Amber Dubois will be hosting a Search and Rescue Training Program. This will be a 3-4 day program consisting of both classroom and field training. This program prepares the student for the Search and Rescue Technician Level III certification from the National Association of Search and Rescue (NASAR). This test can be administered on-line at www.nasar.org for an additional fee.

Schedule for Training includes:

April 15th 6:00 to 9:00pm (Classroom)

April 16th 6:00 to 9:00pm (Classroom)

April 17th 9:00am to 4:00pm (Field Exercises - GROUND SEARCHERS)

April 18th 1:00pm to 5:00pm (Field Exercises - EQUINE)

Extra classes will include:

April 16th 9:00am to 12:00pm - Commercial Sexual Exploitation of Children (CSEC)

April 16th 1:00pm to 4:00pm - Introduction to Child Abduction Search Strategies

April 18th 9:00am to 12:00am - Introduction to Search Planning

The student can pick or choose any or all of the classes being offered. Cost for the training is \$125.00 for any/all portions of the workshop and will include a SAR workbook, CD-ROM and course completion certificate.

Students must pre-register for the classes they intend on taking so adequate class materials can be provided. Registration ends April 12^{th} .
